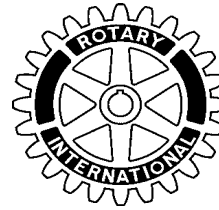

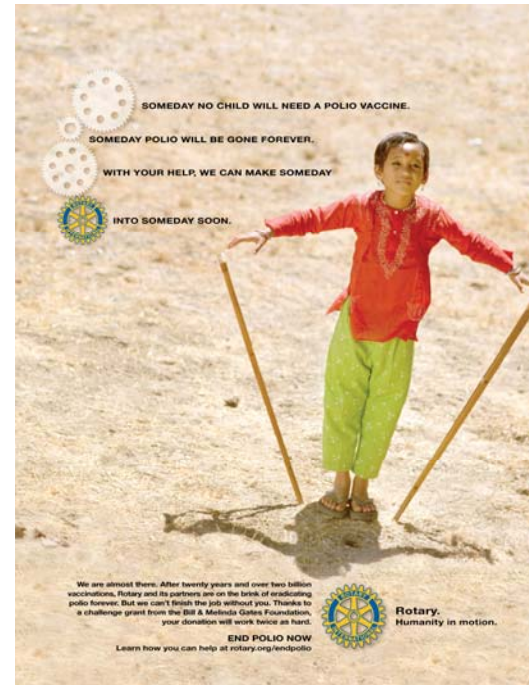

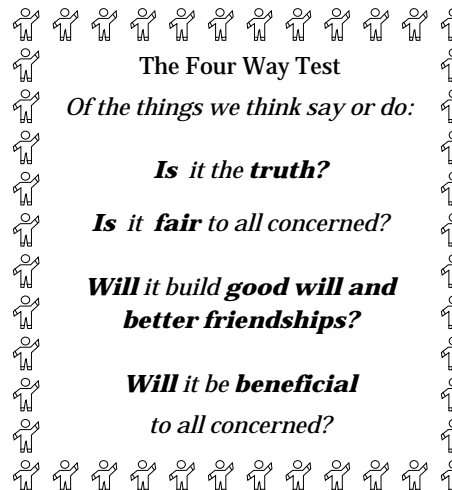

Hmong Culture, Social Structure & Beliefs

- ◆ Do everything for family
- ◆ Men and women have different roles in household
- ◆ Men assume the social roles, religious responsibilities, men are the decision makers and men settle all disputes
- ◆ Women run household and are responsible for parenting
- ◆ Family history is traced thru the male line — there are 18 clans (each clan has same last name) — can't marry within same clan
- ◆ Humility is highest virtue
- ◆ There are 300,000 Hmong in US — California, Minnesota, Wisconsin and North Carolina are the 4 largest populated states of Hmong.
- ◆ Hmong are mostly from Laos
- ◆ Religious Beliefs—ancestral worshipping (very private & no church) — believe in existence of soul, reincarnation, life after death, judgment, sin
- ◆ About 35 to 40% of Hmong in NC are Christians
