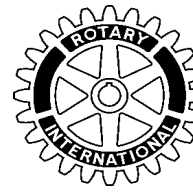

Last week our speaker was Representative Mitchell Setzer of the N.C. House of Representatives representing the 89th District (which includes Catawba and Iredell Counties). Mitchell's presentation was exceptional and informative and was particularly timely having followed election day the previous day, and Mitchell reviewed both what his role is and what the House does for the state of North Carolina and our area. Mitchell pointed out how N.C. will be swearing-in a new governor (elected the night before), and also handed out information about proposed legislation that will be discussed in committee concerning the idea of improving boating safety on N.C.'s waters, which would include Lake Norman. Rotary License Plates Now Available in N.C.

A North Carolina specialty license plate – the Rotary Plate – is now available from the NC Department of Motor Vehicles and is available for just an additional \$10.00 over and above the cost of a regular plate. Thus, if your current plate has a \$20.00 renewal fee, the Rotary plate has an annual renewal fee of \$30.00.
